



Safety Measures in Place

- Only staff, children, and licensing personnel can enter the building.
- We take, record, and track the temperature of every staff and child.
- The staff taking temperatures and walking children to class wear a mask and gloves.
- Health policies are strictly enforced.
- Children use a sticker chart to track how many times a day that they wash their hands.
- Student to teacher ratios are lower than state requirements.
- We space children out during group activities and when lining up.
- We have enhanced our cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfecting procedures to follow CDC standards.
- Teachers clean and disinfect each room three times a day.
- We have removed all items from the classroom that are often shared but difficult to sanitize.
- Our daily janitorial service uses a hospital grade disinfectant.
- Our top priority is to keep your children safe and healthy!
